



FLINT HILLS BEEF

Production Requirements:

- Cattle must meet GAP 4 standards.
- No antibiotics, No growth promoting hormones, vegetarian diet.
- No ractopamine or beta-agonists.
- Cattle must have EID tag allowing them to be traceable to the ranch of Origin.
- Cattle must be grain fed with a focus on achieving Choice and Prime quality grade.
- No Dairy cattle.
- We encourage producers to follow Beef Quality Assurance guidelines.

Cattle will be inspected by a NextGen representative upon arrival at the finish feed yard. If they meet NextGen specifications a purchase agreement will be signed outlining the premium and delivery date. The premium will be negotiated between 275-350\$ per head. The base price will be the **USDA 5 area weighted average all beef types steers and heifers dressed delivered price**. Heifers and steers paid the same price. Cattle will be paid on the rail with the following adjustments:

- Starting Price = USDA 5 area weighted average all beef types steers and heifers dressed delivered plus 275-350\$ per head
- Prime + \$15
- Upper 2/3 Choice + \$3
- Select - \$10/cwt. hot weight over 10%, choice/select spread does not apply
- YG4: -8.00\$/cwt. hot weight over 10%
- YG5: -16.00\$/cwt. hot weight
- 1050 - 1099 - 20.00\$/cwt. hot weight
- 1100 and above - 30\$/cwt. hot weight
- <649 -15.00\$/cwt. hot weight
- Over 30s months, No-roll, Heiferettes, commercials, Dark Cutter, Cow, Bull, Stag, Mutilated & junk. - \$50/cwt. hot weight

Carcass data will be supplied by Missouri Prime Beef Packers.

Premiums and Discounts may be revised January 1st & July 1st every year. They will be included in the agreement which is signed on each pen of cattle upon approval of the NextGen Beef Company representative.
